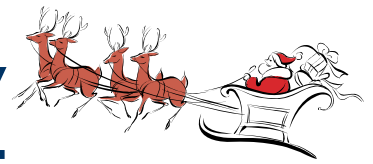

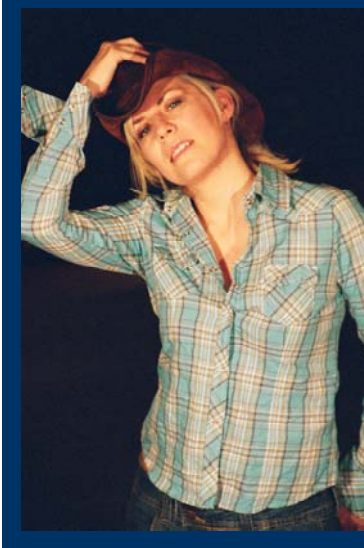

Cowboy Boots and Levis is one of twelve tracks on Kelly Brocks latest CD "Rebel Kind" due to be released in early 2007. With foot tapping melodies and catchy sing-along lyrics, it's not difficult to see why Kelly Brocks future is looking bright.

So what does Keith Urban have to do with Kelly Brock you ask? Didn't you read the last issue? Ok let me catch you up to speed.

As mentioned in the last issue of *The Brock Buzz*, Kelly's inspiration for writing the song came from not only meeting Keith but also having the pleasure of spending some time with the Aussie heartthrob during a brief song-writing trip to Nashville.

I recently talked with Kelly about her trip and what it was about Keith that inspired her so much.

NH – Tell me about your trip to Nashville and meeting with Keith Urban?

KB - In 1996 I sang in a folk duo called Juliet and Juliet with a girlfriend of mine named Gwen Holt. We decided to go to Nashville to do some song-writing and a few music showcases. We had a publisher friend down there that we hung out with and he just happened to be room-mates with Keith, who at the time was unknown and was trying to break into the country music scene in North America. We all hung out one night, went for dinner and then went back to their pad to jam and party. The next evening Keith had a showcase for a really powerful manager at the time, Miles Copeland who had managed The Police and Alannah Miles. As far as I can remember he had been quite successful in his native home of Australia and had moved to Nashville hoping to expand his audience. He certainly impressed me that evening, with his guitar chops and singing. His band was wicked as well! It was obvious that he had a really good chance of doing something in the biz but who would have known that he would become the big celebrity that he is today- pretty crazy stuff!

NH – Sounds like fun! What was it about him that inspired you?

KB - Well, first of all even back then, he was a little hottie! He really was very charming with his Aussie accent, long blond locks and of course his amazing

musicianship! So I think I may have had a little crush on him at the time and then after seeing him do his thing on stage I was blown away- so much that it inspired me to jot down some lyric ideas that eventually turned themselves into the song, *Cowboy Boots and Levis*.

NH – That was in the mid nineteen nineties. Why did you wait until now to write and release the song?

KB - It's funny- I just didn't feel that it was ever the right time to finish off that song until now. I had those lyrics and a melody idea that I carried around on a cassette tape with me for years. I had literally forgotten about it when one day I was getting ready to move and decided to go thru a bunch of old cassette tapes and there it was. I thought, damn this is a pretty cool little song idea- I better finish it!

NH – I've listened to the song many times and have to say it is one of my favourites on the CD.

KB – Thanks- it is one of my faves as well! I love that the track has a funky/bluesy groove to it - kind of a Bonnie Raitt vibe. I also love the fiddle parts- it really makes the song for me! ☺

Although Kelly at the time hadn't heard anything about Keith's childhood, she wrote into the song a line about a guitar toy that he would play with as a child. Now jump forward a decade to today and you'll find Keith Urban's picture and music just about anywhere. You can imagine Kelly's delight when she stumbled across a picture in *OK Magazine* of little boy Keith, looking ever so cute holding his toy guitar.
