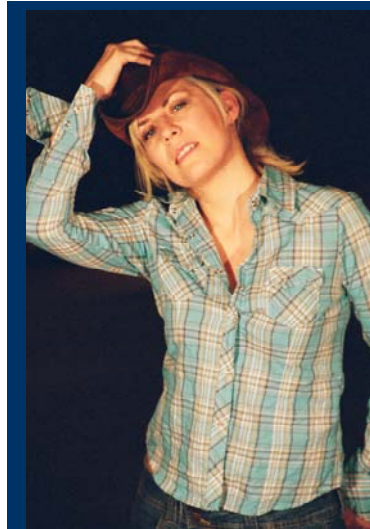

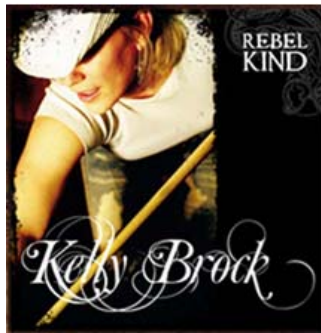

West coast country/rocker Kelly Brock makes her sophomore appearance on disc, with *Rebel Kind* a follow-up to her 2002 *Dirty Dishes* album. As the title suggests, there's plenty of hard-edge, rebel, outlaw flavour in the lady's music, not unlike some of Patricia Conroy's early career outings. Kelly Brock is also a talented songwriter, with her pen in ten of the songs presented here.

The standout items on the album include the pop/country *Wake Up* (not the Merle Haggard song) which has some tasty acoustic instrumentation; a mid-tempo, name-dropping ditty in *DJ Play A Drinking Song*; and the lead single, *Cowboy Boots And Levis*, a funk country effort that is currently charting nationally for Kelly Brock. Listen also for *Movin' On*, a torchy ballad, with Pop undertones, as a potential single release.

The album is heavily weighted with country/rockers like the title track *Rebel Kind*, as well as *Thirty Something* and *Keep it Real*. Special guest Barry Mathers (of *The Cruzeros*) provides vocal accompaniment on the mellow love song *Be My Angle*; while Barney Bentall and son Dustin Bentall are heard on the country/pop item, *Vegas*. The album closes with a gratuitous cover of the Lowell George song *Heartache*, previously done by country's Suzy Bogguss and by Valerie Carter.

Rebel Kind was co-produced by Craig Zurba with Kelly Brock, and recorded at studios in Burnaby, B.C. utilizing many of the west coast's finest session players.

West-coast Singer-Songwriter, Kelly Brock releases her second single, "Rebel Kind" to Canadian Country Radio. The song is an up-tempo, country-rocker about throwing caution to the wind and having the courage to follow your dreams.

Brock's first single, "Cowboy Boots and Levis" has been very well-received at country radio and so far has reached #41 on the CMN charts.

Brock's latest CD was co-produced and co-written by Brock and producer/engineer, Craig Zurba and is scheduled to be released May 29th, 2007 through Pacific Music/Warner Music Canada.

KELLY BROCK'S CD RELEASE PARTY TO BE HELD ON JUNE 19TH AT THE MEDIA CLUB IN VANCOUVER, BC

West-coast Singer/Songwriter, Kelly Brock will be celebrating the release of her fourth CD entitled Rebel Kind at the Media Club (695 Cambie Street) on Tuesday, June 19th. She will be joined on-stage with her six-piece band along with special guest Dustin Bentall. Dustin and Barney Bentall both contributed background vocals on Kelly's song "Vegas". The new disc also features some of the hottest female vocalists in town on the track "Thirty-Something". The gals will also be joining Kelly on-stage during her 40 minute set. The night will open up with Bob Kemmis at 9pm, Kelly Brock's set will follow at 10pm and Dustin Bentall and his band will close out the night at 11pm.
